How many people today have integrity? Yes some people still do have it but a good portion do not. The quality of being honest is one thing, but having strong moral principles is another hint all together.

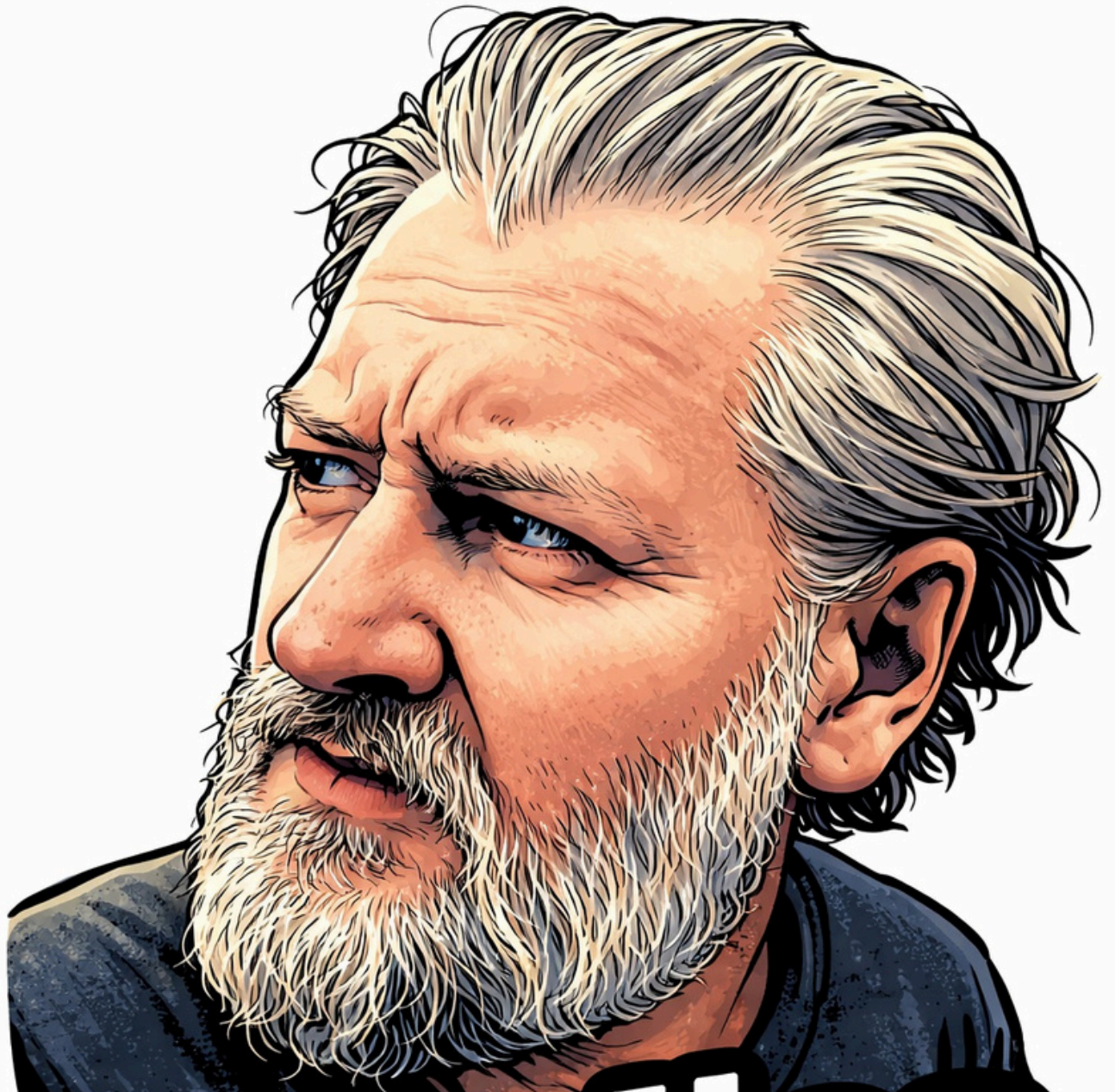
