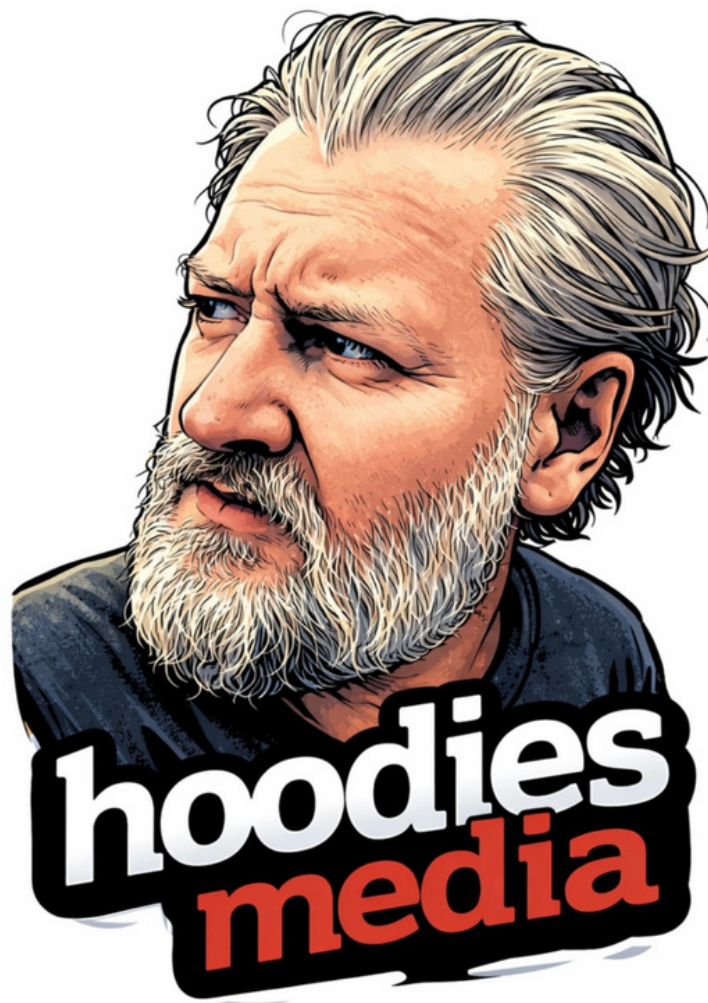

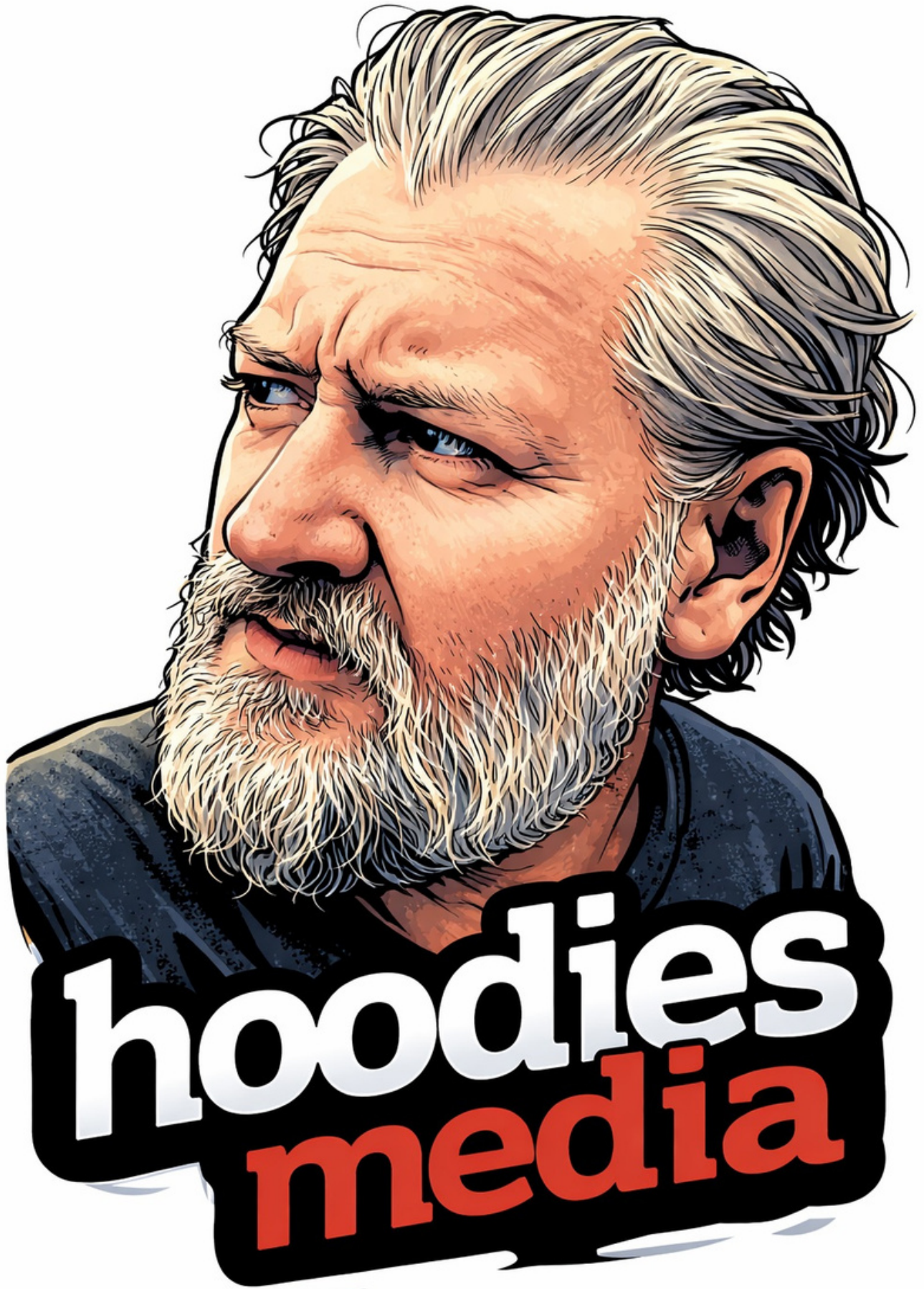
Everything you're doing is wrong
