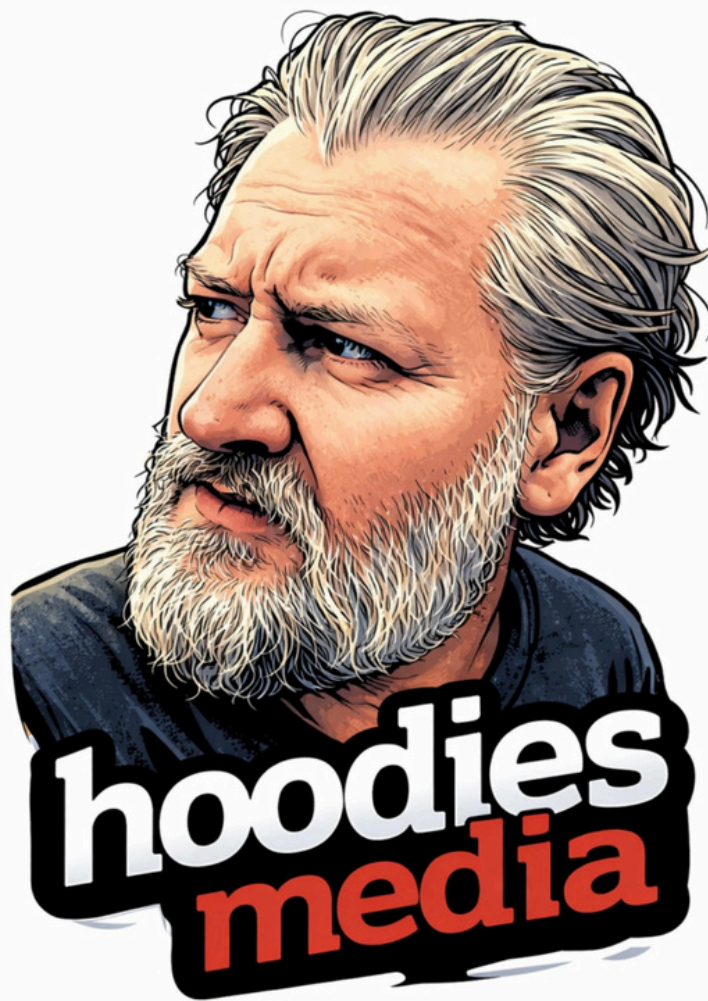

AUSTRALIA AND THE LAST MAN

We talked the other day about how aspiration seems to be dying in Australia. Dying because there are very few incentives for it anymore, no reward for effort. We tell our kids that anything is possible but slug them with university debt they will barely ever be able to get out from underneath and tell them they're unlikely to ever own a home. Cost of living is tearing families apart and mental health rates are at all time highs with the state government in Victoria so corrupt people are thinking they'd be better off taking up a life of crime.

This whole lack of aspiration thing got me thinking and reading and I came across the well known idea of the Last man as spoken about by Nietzsche. The last man is unable to create, avoids struggle and ambition and never strives to be exceptional. The book was written between 1883 and 1885, more than 120 years before the first smart phones appeared and more than 130 years before left wing governments began to attack free thinking and creativity.

George Orwell's book 1984 was written in 1947 and managed to predict with some degree of accuracy what our life would become. Orwell like Nietzsche saw that man had the potential to be easily led by people focused on greed power and the eradication of aspirational thought. In 2026 you'd have to suggest they were both right.

We still have a chance to prove both Orwell and Nietzsche wrong and my god I hope we do, but we need to understand that the choice is actually ours no matter what any kind of politician or bureaucrat may say. Aspire to do great things and some may actually happen along the way!

Even here in Australia our very own Albo has said we should watch and listen to mainstream media because they don't deal in half truths and misinformation, but really? The trust in msm today is it lowest ever recorded and funnily enough the federal government want us to believe it? Come on.

Independent media matters, impartiality matters and having both is what keeps the bastards honest. So long live the New York Times and long live freedom of the press.

OH ENGLAND WHAT HAVE YOU DONE

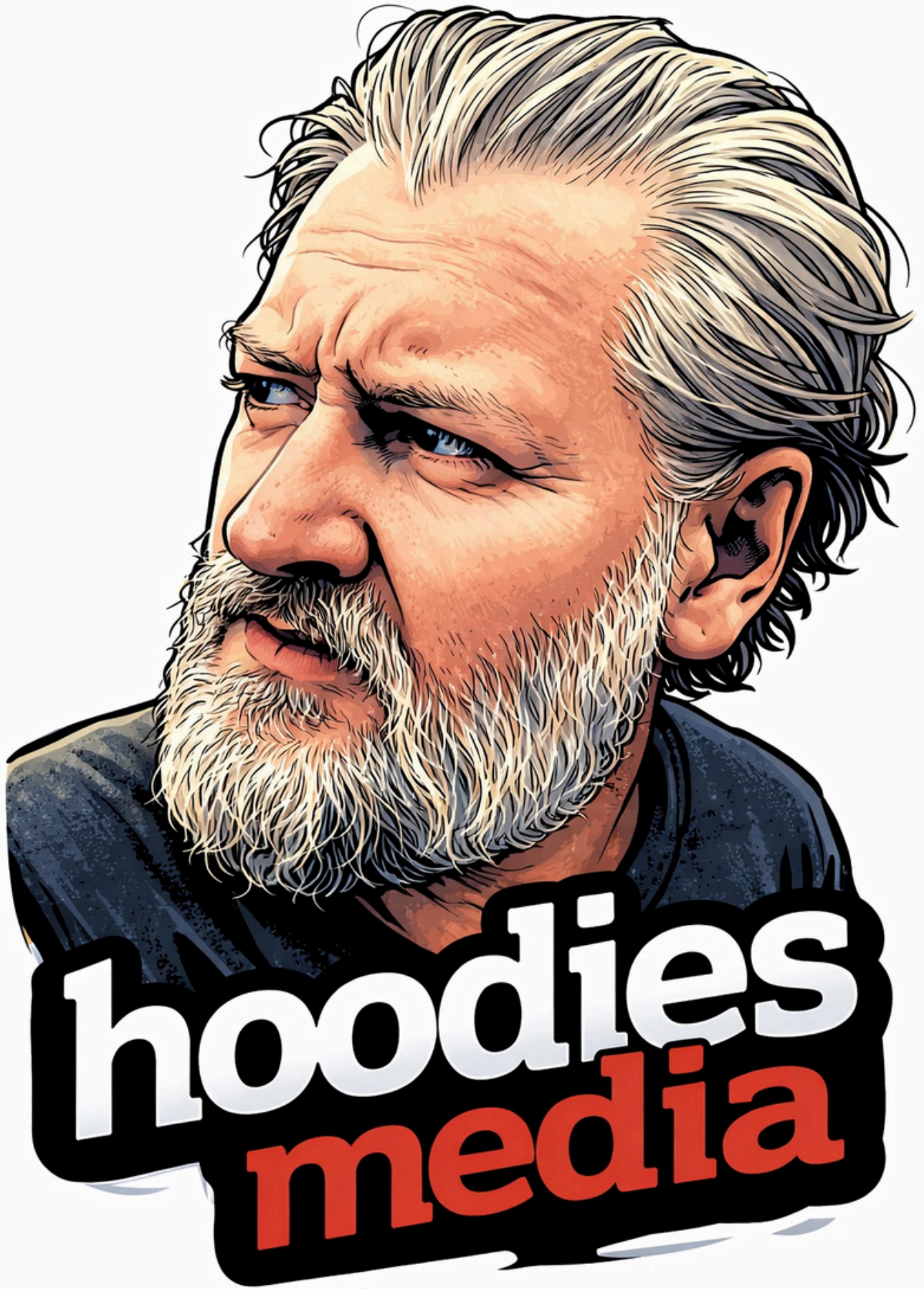
Did anyone see Messi's face when Jude Bellingham gave it to him at half time? Messi argued for a moment but then said ok sure good luck with that and England lost 2-1.
