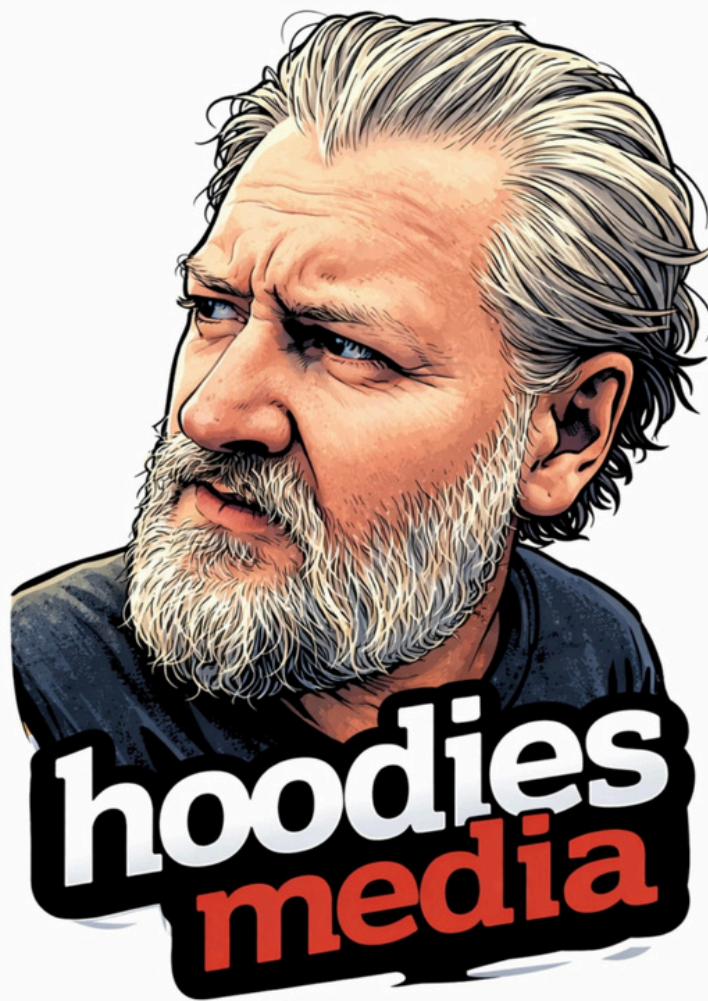

PAULINE LIGHTS UP THE SPOTLIGHT

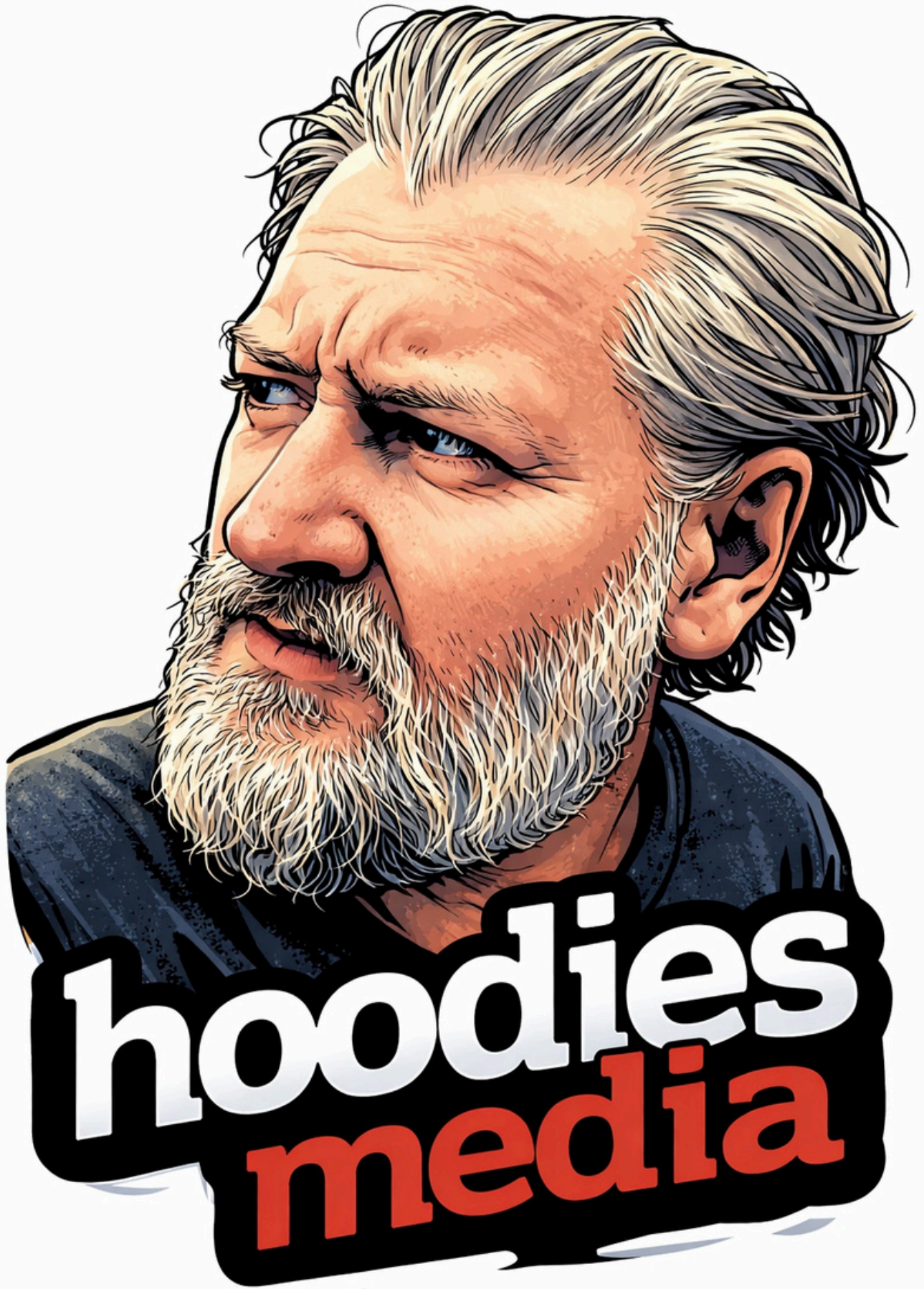
