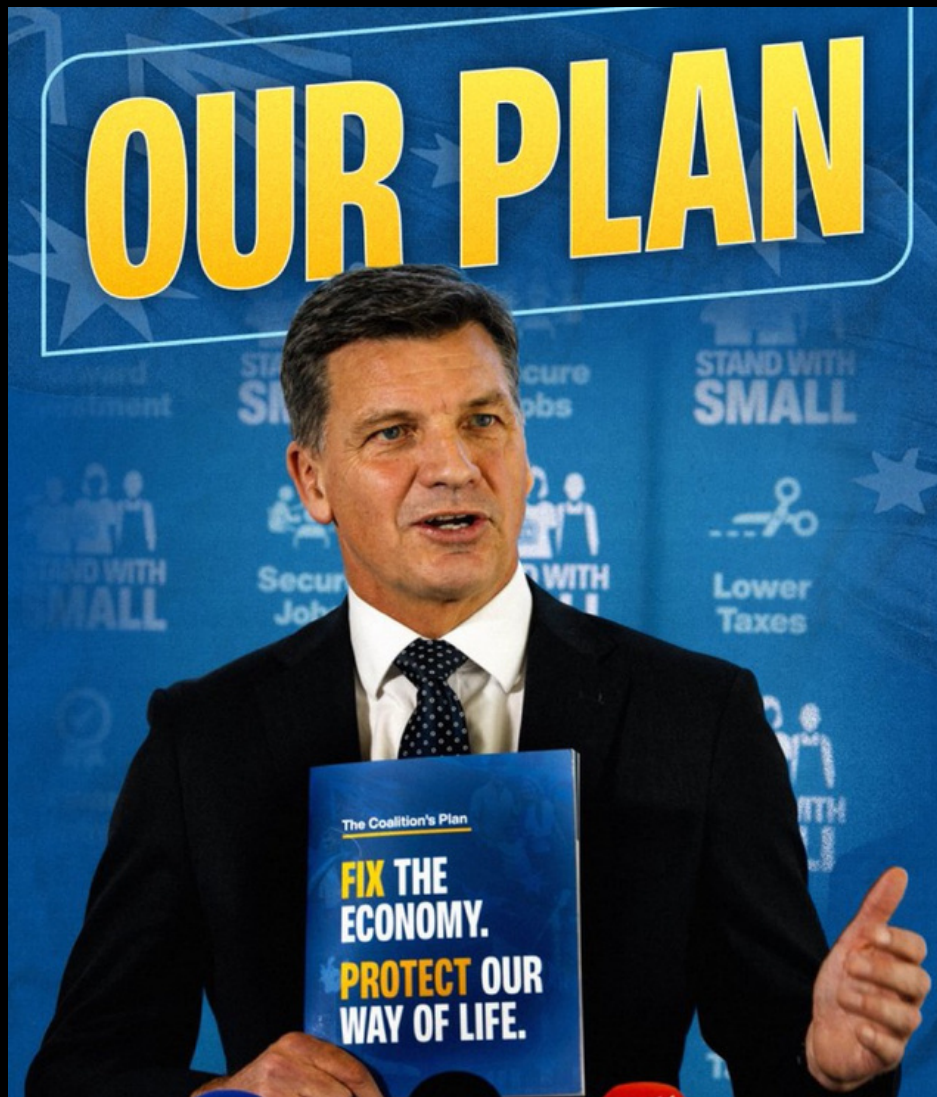
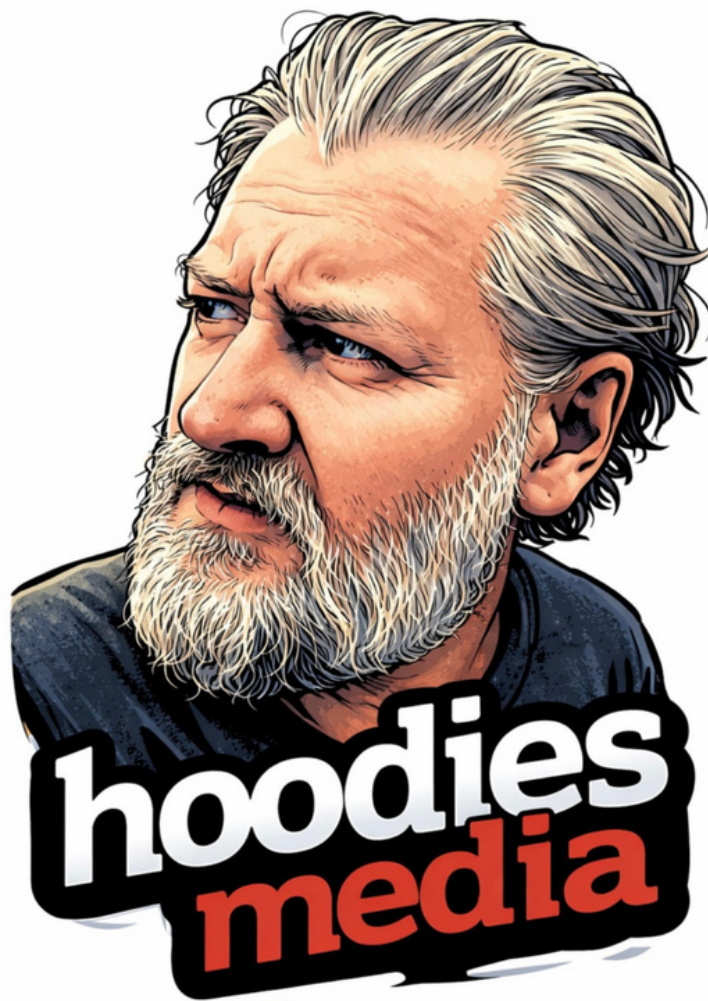

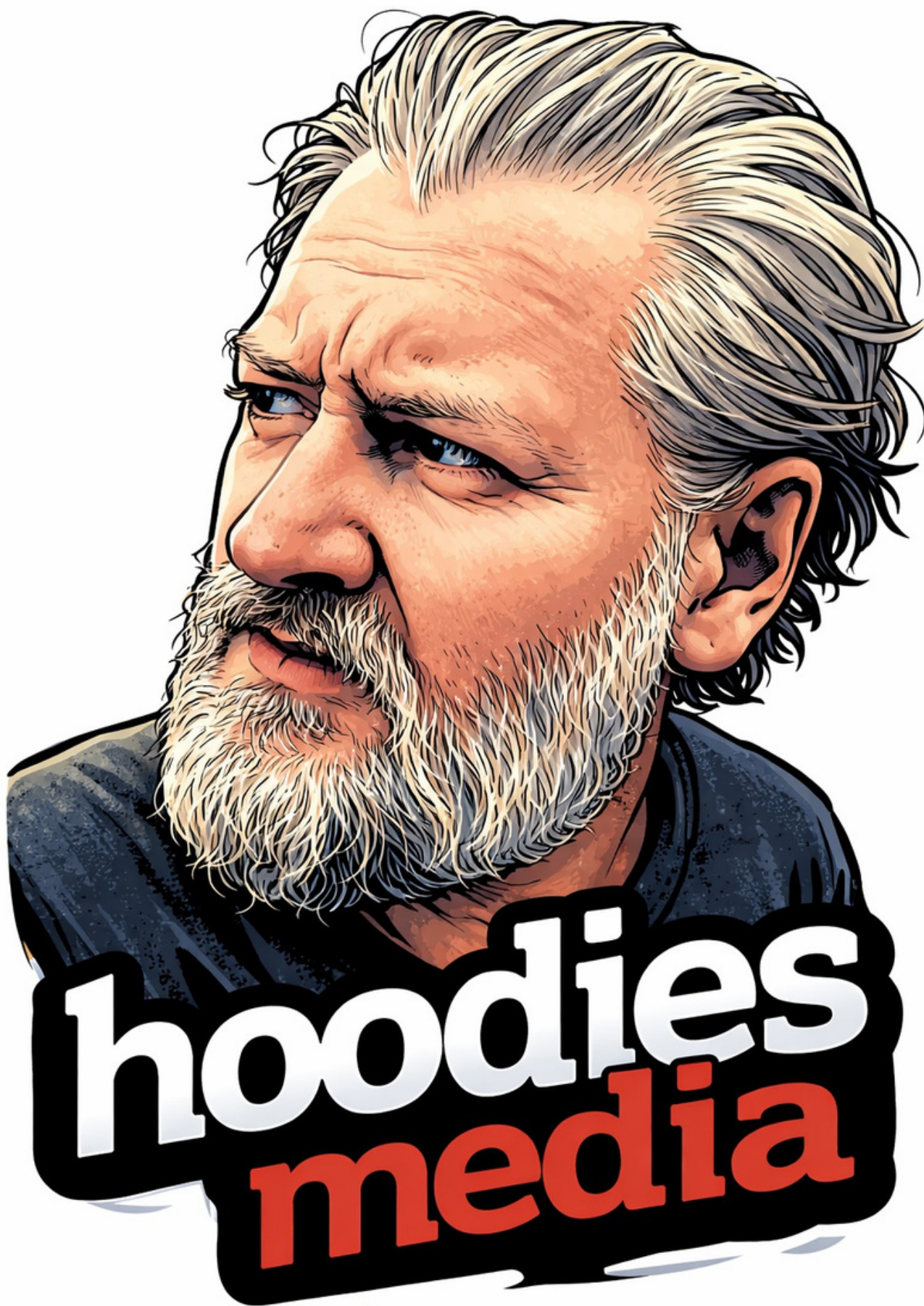
Who can afford those rates? Who thinks a small business owner can afford to be open on days when they should be flat out all because the barista has to be paid between \$52 and \$67 an hour?!
