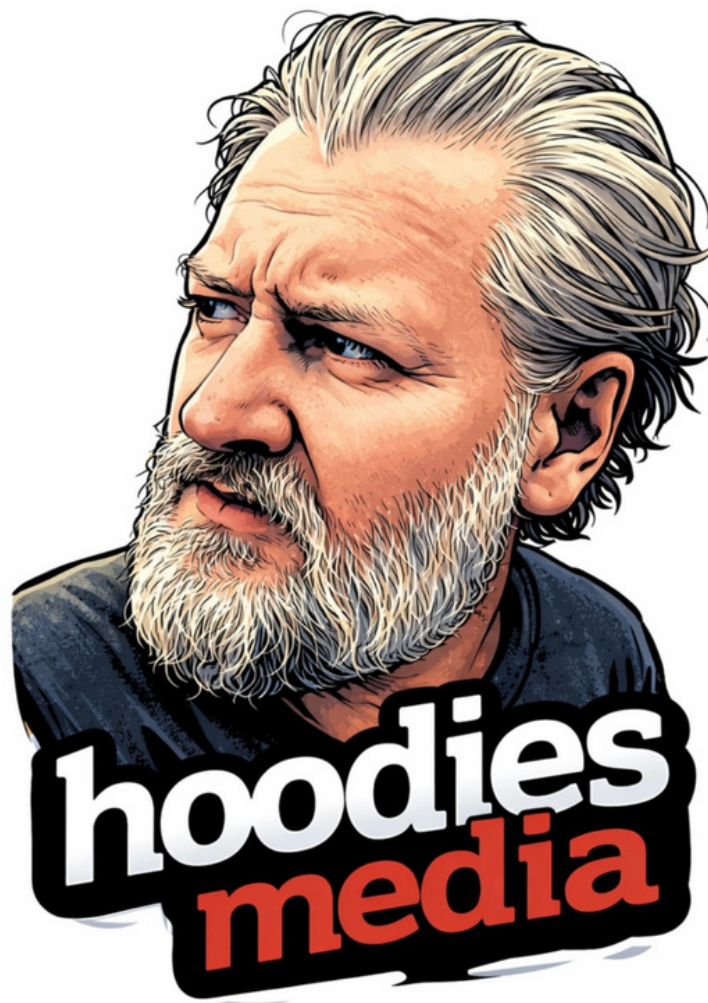

She withdrew from her family, friends and life to the point where she was a shell. She was covered in sores and her face had become grey and she looked like death...I have never forgotten it. The same when youth offenders were taken through mainstream prisons and showed by real crime what jail was really like. It scared the shit out of these kids. It changed them.

Today where are those ads? Those programs that showed a different way forward? Parental help with difficult kids? Youth support? Programs to get youths into apprenticeships? We need trades, we need data technicians so why not help these kids learn the skills?

Bail laws have been made tougher and? Yes real arseholes need to go to prison but what if the stupid dumb ass who made the wrong decisions? We can't let all kids rot in jail...

Having spent some time in foster care the way to help disadvantaged youth isn't to lock them up it's to take them and show them another way forward. It's to show them they can be worthy members of society and that pulling machetes on other kids ain't the way to a happy life. Can we fix the system and help? Yes, but we're running out of time and we need to act now.

MOIRA'S LAST STAND?

The end is nigh for Moira Deeming and she is running out of friends fast, mostly because of her own actions.

Pauline Hanson who was interviewed on 3AW yesterday said that she wouldn't have Moira anywhere near One Nation because Moira isn't a team player. Creativity

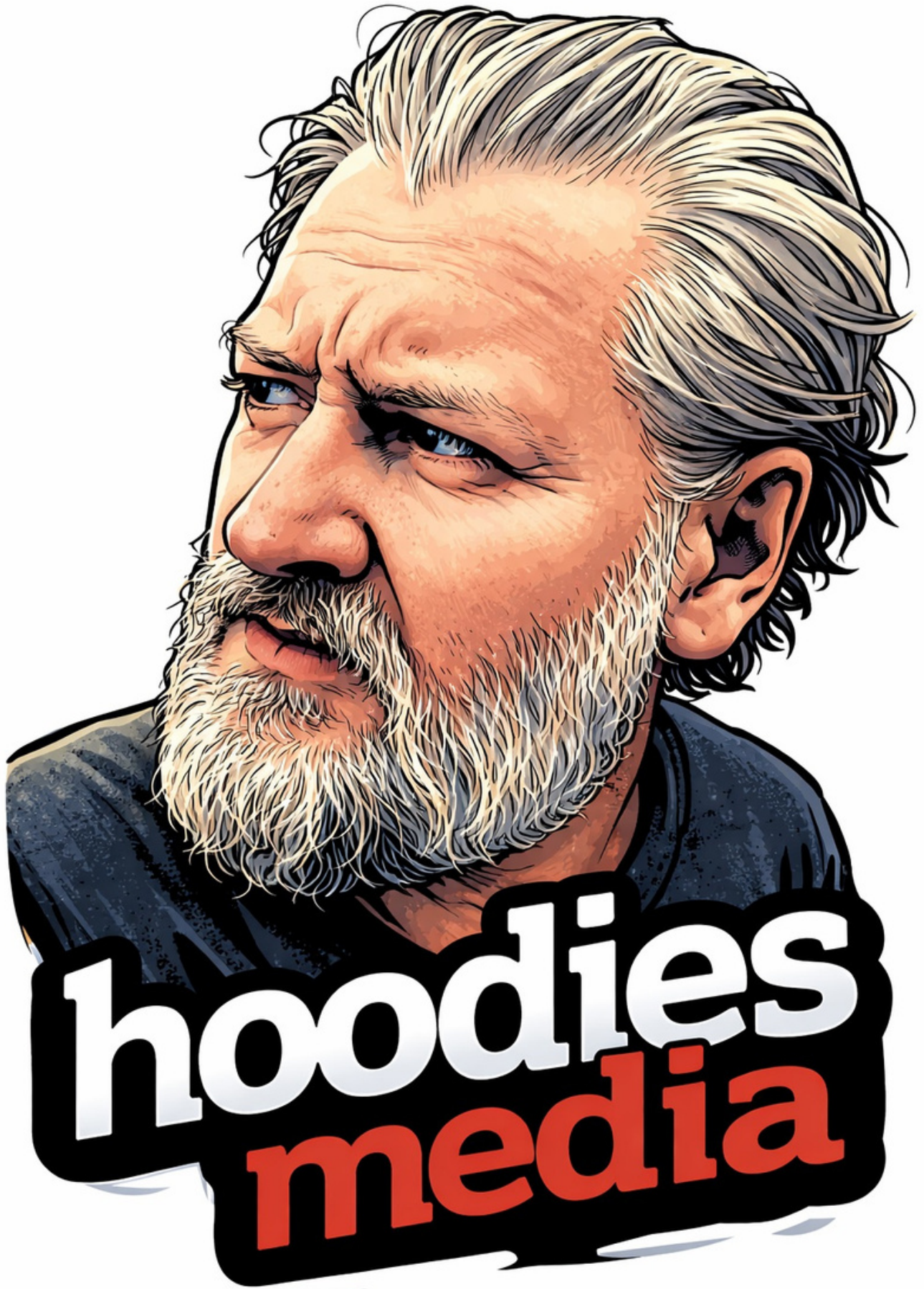
